As you may be aware, the Tripartite Guidelines on Fair Employment Practices have been enhanced following Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong's call at the 2011 National Day Rally for tripartite partners to develop guidelines so that Singaporeans remain the core of the workforce.

The enhanced guidelines released on 31 Oct indicate the reasonable efforts that employers should make to attract and consider Singaporeans for job positions on merit, and to train and develop the potential and careers of Singaporeans. TAFEP and MOM will make reference to this set of guidelines when addressing complaints of alleged unfair employment practices.
