

## Briefing on the Extension of the WSH Act

The Workplace Safety and Health (WSH) Act will be extended to cover all workplaces on 1 Sept 2011. This will include shopping malls and offices that conduct public administration, business services, finance and insurance activities, and in educational institutions.

SHRI is now the RMAF Agent for the purpose of administrating the risk management assistance fund. Also in line with this, SHRI is organising this briefing session on the extension of the WSH Act together with the WSH Council. The forum will provide HR practitioners with the opportunity to learn on common workplace hazards and the measures that can be put in place mitigate them and also to learn about the bizSAFE programme that can help companies to put in a safety system.

Participants can also use the opportunity to find out the various outreach programme and tools available to help their companies build up their safety system.
