

SHRI Engage – The Re-employment Challenge – setting up for success

Today the demands of the work place involve continuing change and increasing complexity. Older workers are often slower to adapt and to acquire new skills. Satisfactory past performance does not guarantee future success. Re-employment initiatives often involve assignment of older workers to lower level roles with reduced remuneration, and, if not well planned, could easily result in reduced productivity and motivation, with all that entails.

In this half day session we will explore how the techniques of job analysis can be used to identify the entire range of demands that come with a role, the risk points for older workers, and the potential sources and impact of poor performance.

Using this structured analysis, participants will be able to assess how roles can be re-engineered to remove risk and provide a better balance of effort, capability and reward for the re-employed. They will gain a good understanding of how the work environment can be optimized for older workers, how their knowledge and wisdom can be captured and retained, and what is realistic in terms of training expectations.

Each attendee will leave with a set of practical tools they can quickly and simply implement in their organization.

About the Speaker:

Leanne is an organizational psychologist with extensive experience in job analysis and design. Since 1993 she has been involved in HR consulting, completing projects for many of New Zealand's larger businesses and Government departments, as well as smaller businesses, across a broad range of industries.

Through Centranum Group she is also involved in the design and provision of on line performance management, capability development and succession planning systems. Her client base spans New Zealand, Singapore, the Middle East and the USA.

Leanne has lectured in Psychology, and related Business, HR and IT topics at various New Zealand universities. She is an industry adviser to the University of Auckland.
